## **The Secretary's Annual Report for the 2025 Season – January 2026 AGM.**

### **Committee Progress.**

With a full complement of Committee members throughout the 2025 season meetings have been constructive & a pleasure to attend.

### **2025 Membership.**

Full Membership similar, Assoc. Membership was well down compared to last season.

### **Fladbury Fishery.**

**Last Season:-** We had a very dry year resulting in a low & clear river for most of the season. Less maintenance required although we replaced platforms & reduced the height of many of the steps. The oxygenated water around Pegs 22 to 26 framed all season.

**Match Turnout:-** Turnout on the Canal matches was this seasons surprise, boosted by the mild winter we had 14 keen canal anglers out over the series continuing into November & December.

**Help running the Matches:-** I cannot emphasise strongly enough how much help I have had running the matches last season. On the River & Canal Matches, Roger, Dave, H. & Gary all helped with pegging out & weighing in, similarly, Pete, Andy C. & Tony D on the pools, all much appreciated, thank you.

### **Finance.**

**Format:-** I am keen to continue with the accounting format we have used for the last 3 or 4 seasons where we separate sources of income. The advantages being Club Prize Money is linked to the level of full subscriptions (affordable) & Fladbury income is spent on the fishery rather than being absorbed.

Fladbury Income is a variable dependant on Associate membership & club bookings but regularly fails to cover Fladbury maintenance costs. The format is being gradually tweaked but a huge step forward compared to how we used to do it. See the Treasurers 2025 Report.

**Match Sponsorship:-** The format helped the Society pay over 60% of total income into match sponsorship last season, spread between the successful anglers within the Society. See the Treasurers 2025 Report.
