Fladbury maintenance completed in 2017

We completed 16 sets of robust steps with the remainder having renewed temporary steps. We completed 2 more raised platforms and 12 bottom stages, we also renewed all of the signs. Every peg is fishable and safer, well done everyone that helped.

Form;- Pegs that were neglected and not fished in matches for years are now winning matches eg, peg 15 won a club match and Peg 11 has won the last four matches with Chub up to a best weight of 17lb.

2018 Committee Objectives.

The last act of 2017 was to fit bottom stages in pegs 15, 19, 20 & 21. Next season we will complete the remaining seven sets of robust steps (4, 5, 7, 13, 14, 15 & 16) and fit eight bottom stage platforms (1, 3, 4, 10, 11, 12, 14 & 16) so we will have all of the pegs robust, mud free and low maintenance.

New Committee Roles in 2018,

We have decided to regularly discuss measures to attract Fladbury bookings & Brian Barton has accepted the role of promoting bookings, an area that we have to improve. To spread the workload H. Potter has accepted the responsibility for identifying, monitoring & organising all Fladbury maintenance requirements.
