<u>Fish Removal</u>;- Members witnessing fish removal should immediately report the incident to the <u>Angling Trust on 0343 507 7006</u>. Don't get involved, simply make the call & inform the Club Secretary.

#### 1.0: Subscriptions

All members must be fully paid up and in receipt of a membership card before fishing GirlingAS Fladbury Left Bank.

#### 2.0: Members under 16 years of age

Junior members are not allowed on the fishery unaccompanied, an adult must be present taking responsibility for their safety at all times.

#### 3.0: Membership Card / Bailiffs

3.1: The fishery is patrolled by Bailiffs daily, please carry your membership card when fishing Fladbury Left Bank and produce your card on request.

3.2: All members are expected to ask anglers fishing Fladbury to produce their membership card.

#### 4.0: Availability

4.1: Associate and Junior members can fish the match pegs 1 to 26 in the river anytime during day light hours when there are no matches, check the GirlingAS website for availability.

4.2: Pegs 27 to 35 in the Lock Stream are available for pleasure fishing.

#### 5.0: Fishery Rules

5.1: We do not allow bivvies, night fishing, fires or leaving litter and your membership card allows you to fish Fladbury using conventional river methods only during day light hours. , No bolt rigs, heavy pre-baiting or heavy feeding of baits. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the Society.

## 5.2 No removal of fish. Removal of fish will be reported to the Angling Trust and result in expulsion from the Society.

5.3: Do not fish further than the centre of the river if there is an angler on the opposite bank.

5.4: Members must have a Landing Net and retain fish for short periods.

#### 6.0: Parking and Access

6.1: Associate and Junior members please park in the Mill Bank free public car park (over Jubilee bridge on the left). No parking in Neigh Lane by the field gate.

6.2: Access is via Neigh Lane (upstream), through the round steel gate and bere left until you reach the river and the Girling AS notice board in peg 3. Pegs 1 & 2 are downstream, pegs 4 to 26 are upstream. Pegs 27 to 35 are in the Lock Stream and available for pleasure fishing. Members are asked to keep to the river's edge and close all gates.

#### 7.0: Permits

Members can purchase a day permit for a non-member to accompany a member fishing Fladbury, contact the Secretary for permits and allow 3 days for postage. **Guests fishing without a permit will result in the member's expulsion**.

#### 8.0: <u>AGM</u>

Associate and Junior members are welcome to attend the annual AGM but only full members are allowed to vote.
