

## Girling Angling Society - Fladbury LB Fishery Peg by Peg- August 2024

**Match Pegs 1-26 & Lock Stream Pegs 27-35**

**Park behind all of the Pegs & Turn around at Peg 34 / Please don't drive on the crops.**

Peg	Access	Description of Peg	Form
1	Platform, Low Steps, accessed from peg 2	<b>The Chub Peg</b> Accessed from peg 2, Great winter peg when the cabbages have died down.	Not used in matches due to the extensive cabbages near side. Wagglers / Feeder peg. Chub downstream
2	Platform, Steps & a Handrail (Suit. Disabled)	<b>The Roach Peg</b> In the Bay, Roach & Chub trotting towards the cabbages in peg 1, main flow far side	Wins a lot of matches on Pole, Stick or wagglers, mainly Roach, some Chub. Roach on Pellet or Hemp & Tares.
3	Double Raised Platform (Suit accompanied youngster)	<b>The Pole Peg in the Bay.</b> Little flow in front of you. Great peg with water on, rarely used in matches. Shallow around the platform. Ideal for a youngster.	Not used in matches due to the complete lack of flow. Ideal for the Pole or Wagglers downstream
4	Platform, Low Steps & a Handrail (Suit Disabled)	<b>Brian's Peg.</b> Wagglers or Feeder long or you can tease the Stick float into the still water in front of peg 3.	Has won matches on the feeder with Perch.
5	Raised Platforms and Steps due to Silt	<b>Cables Downstream</b> You can trot through on the inside or go long Wagglers or Feeder	Chubby area, all won matches in the past. Big Bream & big Chub caught in pegs 6 & 7
6		<b>Cables Upstream (Pete's Peg)</b> As above	
7		<b>The Deep Peg</b> A bit deeper here, trot through or go long over to the flow	Lots of Small Barbel caught in peg 7 August 2024
8		<b>Peg 8</b> Bit deeper here, go long using wagglers or feeder	
9		<b>The Shallow Peg</b> Quite shallow nearside, you have to go long but stalks to a third over are a problem	Not used in matches due to the nearside Stalks Wagglers Peg.
10	Inside of a Bend, main flow far bank	<b>Winter Peg</b> A little shallow, main flow far side.	Not used in matches unless there's a bit of extra water on.
11		<b>The Chub Peg</b> Chub area which shallows up towards peg 10	Wins lots of matches on the stick then follow them over on the wagglers. Big Roach on Pellet or Hemp & Tares
12		<b>The Shallow Peg</b> Quite shallow nearside, you have to go long but stalks nearside are a problem	Not used in matches due to the nearside side Stalks Wagglers Peg.
13	Similar pegs with similar flow and depth	<b>The Roach Peg.</b> The last peg on the straight just before the bend. Main flow down the middle.	Wins lots of matches with Chub, Roach and the occasional Barbel, Big Roach in 2024
14		<b>The Middle Pegs 14-18</b> Similar pegs with similar flow and depth	Occasional winning pegs, good with a bit more pace. Barbel with increased colour & flow, Hybrids in 2022

18	Bottom Stage Platforms and Steps	<b>Long Trotting Peg</b> Same depth well into peg 18.	Great Stick Float peg, wins a few.
19		<b>Below the Mill Stream</b> Can be pacy with extra flow from the Mill Stream far side	Won with big weights on the whip
20		<b>The Mill Stream Peg</b> Nice glide nearside, turbulent far side due to influx.	Difficult to get the feeding right, Stick or Whip nearside, feeder far side.
21		<b>First Glide</b> Trotting peg as the flow begins to slow down	Super peg on stick or Whip, always lots of Dace.
22	Very Pacey near side	<b>The Bagging Peg</b> Flow, moving away from the near bank.	Wins regularly (all species) due to the extra flow & oxygenated water nearside, difficult to get your bait down
23		<b>The Barbel Peg</b> Flow right under your feet, difficult to get your bait down	Barbel Peg, heavy stick held back and bait dropper, Perch down the margin & over in the backwater. Back eddy over
24		<b>The Washing Machine Peg</b> Flow nearside, usually turbulent	Superb Peg on days with reduced flow, use bait dropper, Barbel & Chub, back eddy over.
25	Mouth of the Channel	<b>The Pole / Whip peg in the Mouth of the Channel</b> Fast flow from the weir far side, there's a slack triangle over to the point of the island, the channel gets deeper. Steep Steps.	Options:- Pole or Link to the island. Whip over the channel. Barbel & Chub on Link with Meat, Perch bottom of Boat Channel, Barbel when coloured.

27	Stages and Steps set high as Winter Pegs	<b>First Peg in the Boat Channel</b> Great peg with a little water on	All 9 Pegs are not used in Matches & ideal for the Pole. Peg 27 in the mouth of the cutting can be brilliant with water on & after the boats have died down Bream in deeper pegs Peg 33, 34 & 35 Peg 34 & 35 have easy access with no steps
28		<b>Lock Stream Pegs 28-31</b> Similar pegs, Shallow in the Summer, best in the winter with water on when the boat traffic has eased.

31	Platform & Steps, deeper nearside	<b>Pole Peg</b> Set low to the water, deeper nearside	Peg 34 & 35 have easy access with no steps
32		<b>Pole Peg</b> Set low to the water, deeper nearside	
33	No Steps, gentle slope to peg. (Suit Disabled)	<b>The Scenic Peg</b> Gentle slope down. Great winter Peg, good depth on the inside. Rubble Platform, very scenic.	<b>Vehicle Turn around area in front of Peg 34</b>
34		<b>Lock Gates (overlooking the weir)</b> Great winter Peg, good depth on the inside. Platform is in front of a tree so a little awkward but very Scenic.	
35	No Steps, Platform situated in front of a tree, a little awkward.
